**ORDER**

On December 13, 2007, Complainant Patricia Baxter (“Baxter”) filed a complaint against Respondents Cook County Government (“Cook County”) and the George Dunne Cook County Administration Building (“69 West Washington Management Company, LLC”), for discrimination based on her disability, in violation of the Cook County Human Rights Ordinance (“Human Rights Ordinance”). The Cook County Commission on Human Rights (“Commission”) has not yet made an evidence determination with respect to this matter, but on May 27, 2014, the Commission received a fully executed Withdrawal Request Form (“Request”) from Baxter.

Pursuant to the Commission’s Procedural Rules:

A Complainant may request to withdraw a Complaint or any part thereof at any time. A Complainant’s request to withdraw a Complaint shall be in writing and shall be signed by the Complainant or his/her attorney of record. Under such circumstances, the request may be presumed to be knowingly and voluntarily made, and the Commission may approve the request and enter an order dismissing the Complaint.



The Request, which was signed by Baxter, states that she “no longer wish[es] to pursue this complaint. The matter has been resolved.” Additionally, in the Request, Baxter attests that she is making her request to withdraw voluntarily and without pressure from any organization or individual.

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission hereby grants Baxter’s request to withdraw her complaint and orders that complaint 2008PA002 be DISMISSED pursuant to a VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL.
