**ORDER**

On April 2, 2012, Complainant Bruno M. Roberto ("Roberto") filed a complaint against Respondent Crown, Cork & Seal USA, Inc. ("Respondent") for disability-based employment discrimination in violation of the Cook County Human Rights Ordinance. The Cook County Commission on Human Rights ("Commission") has not yet made an evidence determination with respect to this matter, but on December 26, 2013, the Commission received a fully executed Withdrawal Request Form ("Request") from counsel for Roberto.

Pursuant to the Commission's Procedural Rules:

A Complainant may request to withdraw a Complaint or any part thereof at any time prior to an Evidence Determination by the Commission. A Complainant's request to withdraw a Complaint shall be in writing, shall be signed by the Complainant or his/her attorney of record, and shall be verified. If the request is knowingly and voluntarily made, the Commission shall approve the request and enter an order dismissing the Complaint.



The Request, which was signed by Roberto and notarized, states that "I no longer wish to pursue this complaint." Additionally, in the Request, Roberto attests that he is making his request to withdraw voluntarily and without pressure from any organization or individual.

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission hereby grants Roberto's request to withdraw his complaint and orders that complaint 2012E014 be DISMISSED pursuant to a VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL.
