ORDER

On January 5, 2011, Complainant Kimberly Bell (“Bell”) filed a complaint against her employer, Respondent Cook County Health & Hospitals System (“CCHHS”), for an alleged violation of the Cook County Human Rights Ordinance (“Human Rights Ordinance”). The Cook County Commission on Human Rights (“Commission”) has not yet made an evidence determination with respect to this matter, but on June 3, 2014, the Commission received a fully executed Withdrawal Request Form (“Request”) from Bell.

Pursuant to the Commission’s Procedural Rules:

A Complainant may request to withdraw a Complaint or any part thereof at any time. A Complainant’s request to withdraw a Complaint shall be in writing and shall be signed by the Complainant or his/her attorney of record. Under such circumstances, the request may be presumed to be knowingly and voluntarily made, and the Commission may approve the request and enter an order dismissing the Complaint.



The Request, which was signed by Bell, states, “I have entered into a private settlement agreement.” Additionally, in the Request, Bell attests that she is making her request to withdraw voluntarily and without pressure from any organization or individual.

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission hereby grants Bell’s request to withdraw her complaint and orders that complaint 2010E050 be DISMISSED pursuant to a VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL.
