ORDER

A status was held in this matter on October 1, 2015 at 10:00 a.m.. Complainant appeared with his attorney. A court reporter was present at the request of the Commission. It is hereby Ordered:

1. No attorney has filed a substitute appearance on behalf of the Respondent. The Respondent has not in any way communicated with Complainant's counsel or this tribunal since the last status.
2. An Order of default is hereby entered against the Respondent for failure to defend this case and/ or appear pursuant to prior Orders.
3. Complainant presented sworn testimony of damages he allegedly suffered as a result of the discriminatory actions of the Respondent.
4. Plaintiff filed a Memorandum on Damages at the start of this status.
5. At the conclusion of the testimony, Plaintiff requested the opportunity to file a brief post hearing memorandum. Plaintiff may file such memorandum within seven days, or on or before October 8, 2015. Counsel will forward a copy by email to the Administrative Law Judge (Joanne.Kinoy@cookcountyil.gov)
6. After a transcript of the hearing is prepared, the Administrative Law Judge will issue a Recommended Decision. If the decision is favorable to the Complainant, his counsel will then have the opportunity, pursuant to the rules of this Commission, to file a fee petition.
