ORDER

On March 16, 2015, Complainant Sammantha Holsclaw (“Holsclaw”) filed the above-captioned complaint against her former employer, Respondent REP Corporation (“REP Corp.”), with the Cook County Commission on Human Rights (“Commission”). Holsclaw alleged that REP Corp. discriminated against her and engaged in unlawful harassment on the basis of her status as a pregnant woman in violation of the Cook County Human Rights Ordinance. The Commission is investigating Holsclaw’s complaint, but had not yet made a determination of whether there is sufficient evidence to support her claims when, on June 30, 2015, the Commission received a fully executed Withdrawal Request Form (“Request”) from Holsclaw.

Pursuant to the Commission’s Procedural Rules:

A complainant may request to withdraw a complaint or any part thereof at any time. A Complainant’s request to withdraw a complaint shall be in writing and shall be signed by the Complainant or his/her attorney of record. Under such circumstances, the request may be presumed to be knowingly and voluntarily made, and the Commission may approve the request and enter an order dismissing the complaint.

CCHR Pro. R. 420.160.

The Request, which was signed by Holsclaw, states that a “Settlement” was reached. Additionally, in the Request, Holsclaw attests that she is making her request to withdraw voluntarily and without pressure from any organization or individual.

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission hereby grants Holsclaw’s request to withdraw her complaint and orders that Complaint No. 2015E005 be DISMISSED pursuant to a VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL.
