ORDER

On June 14, 2011, Complainant Carlos Jimenez ("Jimenez") filed a complaint against his former employer, Respondent Tony's Finer Foods, for an alleged violation of the Cook County Human Rights Ordinance. The Cook County Commission on Human Rights ("Commission") has not yet made an evidence determination with respect to this matter, but on April 24, 2014, the Commission received a fully executed Withdrawal Request Form ("Request") from Jimenez.

Pursuant to the Commission's Procedural Rules:

A Complainant may request to withdraw a Complaint or any part thereof at any time. A Complainant's request to withdraw a Complaint shall be in writing and shall be signed by the Complainant or his/her attorney of record. Under such circumstances, the request may be presumed to be knowingly and voluntarily made, and the Commission may approve the request and enter an order dismissing the Complaint.

The Request, which was signed by Jimenez, states, "I have reached a settlement agreement with the Respondent." Additionally, in the Request, Jimenez attests that he is making his request to withdraw voluntarily and without pressure from any organization or individual.

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission hereby grants Jimenez's request to withdraw his complaint and orders that complaint 2011E019 be DISMISSED pursuant to a VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL.
