ORDER

On September 20, 2012, Complainant Dorothy Marzelli (“Marzelli”) filed a complaint against her employer, Respondent Northwest Community Hospital, for an alleged violation of the Cook County Human Rights Ordinance. The Cook County Commission on Human Rights (“Commission”) has not yet made an evidence determination with respect to this matter, but on March 26, 2014, the Commission received a fully executed Withdrawal Request Form (“Request”) from Marzelli.

Pursuant to the Commission’s Procedural Rules:

A Complainant may request to withdraw a Complaint or any part thereof at any time. A Complainant’s request to withdraw a Complaint shall be in writing and shall be signed by the Complainant or his/her attorney of record. Under such circumstances, the request may be presumed to be knowingly and voluntarily made, and the Commission may approve the request and enter an order dismissing the Complaint.



The Request, which was signed by Marzelli, states, “I no longer wish to pursue the Complaint.” Additionally, in the Request, Marzelli attests that she is making her request to withdraw voluntarily and without pressure from any organization or individual.

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission hereby grants Marzelli’s request to withdraw her complaint and orders that complaint 2012E031 be DISMISSED pursuant to a VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL.
