ORDER

Complainant LaFayette Moore (“Moore”) filed a petition for attorneys’ fees in the above-captioned matter on April 14, 2014. A response by Respondent East Lake Management Group, Inc. (“East Lake”) would ordinarily have been due to the Cook County Commission on Human Rights (“Commission”) within 14 days. CCHR Pro. R. 470.110(C). Moore’s reply brief would have been due 5 days later. *Id.* at 470.110(D).


East Lake, however, did not receive a copy of this petition until May 20, 2014, and on June 2, 2014, moved for an extension of time to explore settlement, and in the alternative, file a response by July 2, 2014, if a settlement cannot be attained. The Commission encourages the amicable resolution of fee disputes and finds that East Lake has requested the extension of its response in good faith and proffered good cause pursuant to CCHR Pro. R. 490.180.

East Lake also requests that Moore’s reply, if any, to its response be extended an additional 16 days to 21 days after the date of the filing of the response. Neither party has proffered a reason for this extension. A reply brief would only be necessary if settlement talks were unproductive. But in light of the proximate federal holiday, the Commission *sua sponte* extends Moore’s reply date to July 11, 2014.

The Commission hereby GRANTS IN PART East Lake’s Motion, allowing East Lake an extension of time to file its response, if necessary, to the fee petition until July 2, 2014, and allowing Moore an extension of time to file his reply, if necessary, until July 11, 2014.
