**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME**

Complainant Crystal Orozco (“Orozco”) filed the above-captioned matter with the Cook County Commission on Human Rights (“Commission”) on November 26, 2014. Orozco and Respondent Summit Food and Liquor (“Summit”) advised the Commission on December 16, 2015, that the parties had settled in this matter. The Commission advised the parties that in light of the settlement, this matter would be dismissed *sua sponte* on January 15, 2016.

On January 15, 2016, the parties requested that the Commission not dismiss this matter for an additional 60 days. At the time of this request, the parties had not yet reduced their agreement to writing. On January 26, 2016, the Commission entered an order partially granting the requested extension to February 16, 2016, and requiring a written status regarding progress towards a written settlement agreement if further time was requested.

On February 16, 2016, Orozco provided this update in an agreed motion requesting an additional extension of time to March 15, 2016. Orozco indicates that the parties executed a written settlement agreement on January 28, 2016, and that two of three agreed upon payments had been made pursuant to that agreement. Summit is scheduled to make its final payment to Orozco on February 29, 2016.

In light of the foregoing, the Commission grants the parties’ requested extension. The Commission will continue to hold this matter in an inactive status on its docket until March 15, 2016. No further extensions will be granted. The parties are to advise the Commission when the monetary terms of the settlement agreement have been satisfied.
