ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Complainant Crystal Orozco ("Orozco") filed the above-captioned complaint with the Cook County Commission on Human Rights ("Commission") on November 26, 2014. Orozco and Respondent Summit Food and Liquor ("Summit") advised the Commission on December 16, 2015, that the parties had reached a settlement. The Commission advised the parties that in light of that settlement, this matter would be dismissed *sua sponte* on January 15, 2016.

At the joint request of the parties, the Commission has twice extended that date to facilitate the execution of a written settlement agreement and the good faith satisfaction of monetary terms. The Commission's most recent Order Granting Extension of Time indicated that the Commission would continue to hold this matter in an inactive status on its docket until March 15, 2016. Order (Feb. 18, 2016). That date has passed without further indication from either party that holding this matter open would facilitate its resolution.

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission now orders that Complaint No. 2014PA001 be DISMISSED.
