ORDER

On August 6, 2013, Complainant Anthony PapaGiorgio ("PapaGiorgio") filed a complaint against Respondent Bridgeview Bank Group for various alleged violations of the Cook County Human Rights Ordinance. The Cook County Commission on Human Rights ("Commission") has not yet made an evidence determination with respect to this matter, but on September 23, 2013, the Commission received a fully executed Withdrawal Request Form ("Request") from counsel for PapaGiorgio.

Pursuant to the Commission's Procedural Rules:

A Complainant may request to withdraw a Complaint or any part thereof at any time prior to an Evidence Determination by the Commission. A Complainant's request to withdraw a Complaint shall be in writing, shall be signed by the Complainant or his/her attorney of record, and shall be verified. If the request is knowingly and voluntarily made, the Commission shall approve the request and enter an order dismissing the Complaint.



The Request, which was signed by PapaGiorgio and notarized, states that "the parties entered into a settlement agreement." Additionally, in the Request, PapaGiorgio attests that he is making his request to withdraw voluntarily and without pressure from any organization or individual.

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission hereby grants PapaGiorgio's request to withdraw his complaint and orders that complaint 2013E024 be DISMISSED pursuant to a VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL.
