ORDER

On January 19, 2007, Complainant Jennifer Sharpe ("Sharpe") filed a complaint against Respondents Loyal Order of Moose Streamwood Lodge No. 2055, Loyal Order of Moose Inc., and Moose International, Inc. (collectively "Respondents") alleging employment and public accommodation discrimination on the basis of gender identity, in violation of the Cook County Human Rights Ordinance ("Human Rights Ordinance"). The Cook County Commission on Human Rights ("Commission") has not yet made an evidence determination with respect to Sharpe's allegations, but on February 4, 2014, the Commission received a fully executed Withdrawal Request Form ("Request") from Sharpe.

Pursuant to the Commission's Procedural Rules:

A Complainant may request to withdraw a Complaint or any part thereof at any time prior to an Evidence Determination by the Commission. A Complainant's request to withdraw a Complaint shall be in writing, shall be signed by the Complainant or his/her attorney of record, and shall be verified. If the request is knowingly and voluntarily made, the Commission shall approve the request and enter an order dismissing the Complaint.



The Request, which was signed by Sharpe and notarized, indicates that the parties reached a settlement agreement. Additionally, in the Request, Sharpe attests that she is making her request to withdraw voluntarily and without pressure from any organization or individual.

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission hereby grants Sharpe's request to withdraw her complaint and orders that complaint 2007E009/2007PA003 be DISMISSED pursuant to a VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL.
