ORDER

On October 16, 2013, Complainant Kimberly Sullivan (“Sullivan”) filed a complaint against Respondents Tan Hao/Home Realty Group, Su Peizhong and Gu Yesheng (collectively, “Respondents”) for housing discrimination on the basis of source of income in violation of the Cook County Human Rights Ordinance. The Cook County Commission on Human Rights (“Commission”) has not yet made an evidence determination with respect to this matter, but on December 20, 2013, the Commission received a fully executed Withdrawal Request Form (“Request”) from Sullivan.

Pursuant to the Commission’s Procedural Rules:

A Complainant may request to withdraw a Complaint or any part thereof at any time prior to an Evidence Determination by the Commission. A Complainant’s request to withdraw a Complaint shall be in writing, shall be signed by the Complainant or his/her attorney of record, and shall be verified. If the request is knowingly and voluntarily made, the Commission shall approve the request and enter an order dismissing the Complaint.



The Request, which was signed by Sullivan and notarized, states that “[a] settlement has been reached.” Additionally, in the Request, Sullivan attests that she is making her request to withdraw voluntarily and without pressure from any organization or individual.

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission hereby grants Sullivan’s request to withdraw her complaint and orders that complaint 2013H002 be DISMISSED pursuant to a VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL.
