ORDER

On October 21, 2010, Complainant Sheryl Webster (“Webster”) filed a complaint against Respondent Weight Watchers International, Inc. for sex (pregnancy) discrimination and retaliation, in violation of the Cook County Human Rights Ordinance. The Cook County Commission on Human Rights (“Commission”) has not yet made an evidence determination with respect to this matter, but on December 9, 2013, the Commission received a fully executed Withdrawal Request Form (“Request”) from Webster.

Pursuant to the Commission’s Procedural Rules:

A Complainant may request to withdraw a Complaint or any part thereof at any time prior to an Evidence Determination by the Commission. A Complainant’s request to withdraw a Complaint shall be in writing, shall be signed by the Complainant or his/her attorney of record, and shall be verified. If the request is knowingly and voluntarily made, the Commission shall approve the request and enter an order dismissing the Complaint.



The Request, which was signed by Webster and notarized, states that she “no longer wish[es] to pursue this Complaint.” Additionally, in the Request, Webster attests that she is making her request to withdraw voluntarily and without pressure from any organization or individual.

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission hereby grants Webster’s request to withdraw her complaint and orders that complaint 2010E043 be DISMISSED pursuant to a VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL.
