

## MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

THE COUNTY OF COOK

CITY OF BERWYN

RIDGELAND AVENUE  
(Pershing Road to Ogden Avenue) AND  
(26<sup>th</sup> Street to Roosevelt Road)  
31<sup>ST</sup> STREET  
(Harlem Avenue to Ridgeland Avenue)

This MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT, made and entered into by and between the COUNTY OF COOK, a body politic and corporate of the State of Illinois, hereinafter called "COUNTY", and the CITY OF BERWYN, a body politic and corporate of the State of Illinois, hereinafter called "CITY".

### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the CITY, by Agreement, currently maintains County Route Ridgeland Ave from Pershing Road to Ogden Ave and from 26<sup>th</sup> St to Roosevelt Rd at its expense for the COUNTY, and the COUNTY currently maintains County Route 31<sup>st</sup> St from Harlem Ave to Ridgeland Ave, within the CITY boundaries, both of which are the subject roadways under this Maintenance Agreement (the "ROADWAYS"); and,

WHEREAS, the CITY and COUNTY, through this Maintenance Agreement, resolve to define the range of the respective day-to-day maintenance responsibility of the parties, amount and terms for compensation and other conditions covering the maintenance of these ROADWAYS.

NOW, THEREFORE, that in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the above recitals and other good and valuable considerations, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1) The Superintendent of the COUNTY Department of Highways (hereinafter DEPARTMENT) shall be the administrator of this Agreement on behalf of the County.
- 2) The COUNTY at all times retains ownership and jurisdiction over the ROADWAYS, including but not limited to all permitting authority.
- 3) The CITY reaffirms and agrees that it owns, operates and/or is solely responsible for the maintenance of sidewalks, street lighting, trees in the parkway, parking lanes and municipal infrastructure installed within the right-of-way of ROADWAYS.
- 4) The CITY shall maintain the aforesaid ROADWAYS in a manner satisfactory to the COUNTY; for purposes of the responsibilities of the CITY, the terms "maintain" or "maintenance" include, but are not limited to, all routine surface and pothole repairs, temporary full depth patches, expansion bump removal on bituminous surfaces, crack and joint sealing, cleaning and litter pickup, minor curb and gutter repair, drainage structure repair and cleaning, parkway vegetative control, snow and ice control, street sweeping and other operational services.

- 15) In consideration of the satisfactory maintenance of the ROADWAYS, the COUNTY will pay the CITY as noted on the attached Exhibit A for the first twelve month period covered by this Agreement, said amount payable biannually and equal to one-half of the total annual allowance therein established. Billing dates are established as October 1 and April 1 of the twelve-month period covered by this Agreement.
- 16) The rate of compensation will be adjusted annually at the time of renewal to reflect cost changes and shall be based upon the percentage change of the Construction Cost Index for the preceding year as annually provided by the Illinois Department of Transportation.
- 17) Subject to the reasonable approval of the CITY, which approval will not be unreasonably withheld, the DEPARTMENT may amend this Agreement at the time of any extension by the addition or deduction of lane miles of roadways to be maintained. Compensation will be adjusted proportionally to reflect such additions or deductions.
- 18) As used in this Agreement, the term "delivered" means personal delivery or by first class U.S. mail postage paid. Mail delivery shall be deemed made three (3) business days after proper posting.

I, DAVID D. ORR, County Clerk of Cook County, in the State of Illinois, aforesaid and keeper of the records and files of said Cook County, do hereby certify that The Board of Commissioners of the County of Cook, at their regular meeting held on July 12, 2005, passed the following Resolution:

**RESOLUTION**

**RESOLVED** by the members of The Board of Commissioners of Cook County, Illinois, on behalf of the County of Cook, to authorize and direct its President to execute, by original signature or his authorized signature stamp, three (3) copies of a Maintenance Agreement, attached, with the City of Berwyn, wherein, the City of Berwyn will continue to provide daily routine maintenance of Ridgeland Avenue from Pershing Road to Ogden Avenue and from 26<sup>th</sup> Street to Roosevelt Road and assume daily routine maintenance of 31<sup>st</sup> Street from Harlem Avenue to Ridgeland Avenue, said maintenance responsibilities described in the Agreement; in consideration of the satisfactory maintenance of said roadways, the County will pay the City of Berwyn an allowance in the amount of \$13,796.38 for the first twelve month period covered by this Agreement, said amount payable biannually and equal to one-half of the total annual allowance and adjusted annually pursuant to the Agreement; the County at all times retains ownership and jurisdiction over said roadways; and, the Department of Highways is authorized and directed to return an executed copy of this Resolution with Agreement to the City of Berwyn and implement the terms of the Agreement.

All of which appears from the records and files of my office.
