

AMENDMENT NO. 1

This Amendment modifies Contract No. 10-41-95, for Architectural and Engineering Design Services for the Countywide Exterior Wall Repair Project, Building Group 2, Package C by and between the County of Cook, Illinois, herein referred to as "County" and Holabird & Root LLC, authorized to do business in the State of Illinois hereinafter referred to as "Contractor".

RECITALS

Whereas, the County and Contractor have entered into a Contract approved by the County Board on May 18, 2010, (hereinafter referred to as the "Contract"), wherein the Contractor is to provide Architectural and Engineering Design Services for the Countywide Exterior Wall Repair Project, Building Group 2, Package C (hereinafter referred to as the "Services") from September 1, 2010 through December 15, 2015, in an amount not to exceed \$613,250.00; and

Whereas, an increase in the amount of \$34,650.00 has been identified for the continuation of Services; and

Now therefore, in consideration of mutual covenants contained herein, it is agreed by and between the parties to amend the Contract as follows:

1. The contract is increased by \$34,650.00 and the Total Contract Amount is revised to \$647,900.00.
2. This Contract is hereby amended to incorporate Exhibit A and made part of the Contract.
3. This Contract is hereby amended to incorporate the 2014 Economic Disclosure Statement and made part of the Contract.
4. All other terms and conditions remain as stated in the Contract.

Dear Warrick:

As previously agreed upon, below is our request for additional services related to garage stair modifications due to existing conditions, a 15 week adjustment for contract time for meetings and 11 weeks for additional construction observation time.

Following is an additional services request for 1) construction duration extending past the original contract for which Holabird & Root and our consultants are to provide construction administration and observation services.

The total of this request for both construction administration and construction observation services, and for additional time for construction observation beyond the contractual obligation is for \$34,650 and includes fees related to the following:

- 1) The compensation outlined in the Professional Services Agreement between the County and Holabird & Root was based on a 12 month or 255 working day schedule for construction. Substantial completion was reached on September 16, 2014, 365 working days after the start of construction. Eliminating the weeks that we did not meet or were not on site during the winter shutdown, this is 15 weeks more than defined in the contract the County has with Holabird & Root for professional services

These additional services are indicated as follows on an hourly basis as per our contract and indicated as either additional time for either Construction Administration or Construction Observation: Services are broken down by role and by anticipated task on a per week basis:





Dear Warrick:

Following is an additional services request for 1) construction duration extending past the original contract for which Holabird & Root and our consultants are to provide *construction administration* and *observation* services, and 2) for services related to the time extension Madison Construction is seeking to complete the project. This request supercedes the requests from March 26, 2013.

The total of this request for both construction administration and construction observation services, and for additional time for construction observation beyond the contractual obligation is for \$71,220 and includes fees related to the following:

- 1) The compensation outlined in the Professional Services Agreement was based on a 12 month or 255 working day schedule for construction. Per the contract for construction with Madison Construction, they are allowed 330 working days (455 calendar days) to complete the project. This is 75 more working days, or 15 weeks more than defined in the contract the County has with Holabird & Root for professional services.
- 2) In an email dated July 2, 2013 Madison construction indicated an expected substantial completion date at the end of August. This translates into 62 calendar days, equating to approximately 45 working days or 9 more weeks. We request additional fees this extension as well.

For optional additional time beyond the contractual obligation of 20 hours per week, we request \$4194:

- 3) In the month of June, on average, Holabird & Root spent 4.5 more hours on site per week beyond the 20 hour contractual obligation due to Madison completing drops more quickly in order to complete the job. We forecast that this will continue until substantial completion, which Madison has indicated will be at the end of August. This is identified as a separate cost in the below breakdown. If this is not acceptable to the County, we will adjust our strategy for reviewing the drops and other work in order to keep within the 20 hour obligation. Please advise.

If the Undersigned is awarded a contract pursuant to the procurement process for which this EDS was submitted (the "Contract"), this Economic Disclosure Statement and Execution Document shall stand as the Undersigned's execution of the Contract.

Definitions. Capitalized terms used in this EDS and not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings given to such terms in the Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Request for Proposals, Request for Qualifications, or other documents, as applicable.

"Affiliated Entity" means a person or entity that, directly or indirectly: controls the Bidder, is controlled by the Bidder, or is, with the Bidder, under common control of another person or entity. Indicia of control include, without limitation, interlocking management or ownership; identity of interests among family members; shared facilities and equipment; common use of employees; and organization of a business entity following the ineligibility of a business entity to do business with the County under the standards set forth in the Certifications included in this EDS, using substantially the same management, ownership or principals as the ineligible entity.
