

AMENDMENT NO. 3

This Amendment modifies Contract No. 1855-17459 A, for Preliminary Engineering Services for Pulaski Road/ Crawford Avenue by and between the County of Cook, Illinois, herein referred to as "County" and Alfred Benesch & Company, authorized to do business in the State of Illinois hereinafter referred to as "Contractor":

RECITALS

Whereas, the County and Contractor have entered into a Contract approved by the County Board on January 16, 2020, (hereinafter referred to as the "Contract"), wherein the Contractor is to provide Preliminary Engineering Services for Pulaski Road / Crawford Avenue (hereinafter referred to as the "Services" from February 1, 2020 through January 31, 2023, in an amount not to exceed \$2,452,424.00, with no renewal options; and

Whereas, Amendment No. 1 was executed by the Chief Procurement Officer on October 31, 2022, to increase the contract in the amount of \$149,864.00 and the Total Contract Amount was revised to \$2,602,288.00; and

Whereas, Amendment No. 2 was authorized by the County Board on January 26, 2023, to extend the contract for two (2) years beginning February 1, 2023 through January 31, 2025, include additional scope of services to the contract, and increase the contract in the amount of \$280,439.00 and the Total Contract Amount was revised to \$2,882,727.00; and

Whereas, the Contract will expire January 31, 2025, and the agreed upon Services are still required; and

Whereas, an increase of the Contract amount is required for the continuation of Services; and pursuant to Article 10 Section C of the Contract, the County and Contractor desire to increase the Contract in the amount of \$201,542.00.

Whereas, pursuant to Article 10 Section C of the Contract, the County and Contractor desire to extend the Contract for one (1) year beginning on February 1, 2025 through January 31, 2026.

Whereas, pursuant to Article 10 Section C of the Contract, the County and Contractor desire to include additional scope of services to the Contract; and

Now therefore, in consideration of mutual covenants contained herein, it is agreed by and between the parties to amend the Contract as follows:

1. The Contract is extended through January 31, 2026.
2. The Contract is increased by \$201,542.00 and the Total Contract Amount is revised to \$3,084,269.00.
3. The Contract is hereby amended to incorporate Attachment A and made part of the Contract.
4. The attached updated Identification of Sub-Contractors/Suppliers/Sub-Consultants Form (if applicable and updated), MBE/WBE Utilization Plan forms (if applicable and updated), Certificate of Insurance (if updated), and Economic Disclosures Statement under Attachment B are incorporated and made a part of this Contract.

5. All other terms and conditions remain as stated in the Contract.



With this letter Alfred Benesch & Company (Benesch) is requesting an amendment to the Pulaski Road Phase I contract to address additional tasks and contract adjustments required to complete the Phase I services.

The original contract for the Pulaski Corridor Phase I services was awarded on January 29, 2020. The contract term is set to conclude on January 31, 2025. Since the initial contract award, several new and modified tasks have been identified as necessary to complete the Phase I services in accordance with the initial project solicitation. These tasks were not anticipated in the initial contract and are necessary due to unforeseen circumstances related to the Covid 19 pandemic, environmental resource and preliminary engineering findings, and stakeholder feedback during the course of the Phase I study. Several tasks have been addressed in previously approved contract Amendments #1 and #2. Additional modifications to complete the Phase I services are outlined below and on the attached Amendment 3 Scope of Work document.

During the initial environmental survey, it was determined by IDOT that the existing structure over the Cal-Sag channel is eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places. In accordance with Amendment #2, investigation into all feasible alternatives was performed to meet Section 4(f) requirements. In 2022, CCDOTH performed structural improvements to the Pulaski Road/Crawford Ave bridge over the Cal-Sag Channel which improved its structural condition rating. As a result of these improvements and the 4(f) analysis findings, it was determined that replacement of the structure is no longer needed to meet the purpose and need of this study. Services associated with the replacement of the structure will be removed from the contract and reallocated to other project needs. Project deliverables for the Phase I will be updated to reflect an omission of the existing structure.

Additional services in this Amendment include drainage and utility investigations, updating of environmental documentation, and associated coordination and administration. These are necessary to meet Phase I deliverable requirements for the preferred alternative due to new information identified during the study.

A one-year extension of the contract, to January 31, 2026, is requested with this amendment. An extension of the project schedule is required to address the design modifications and allow for CCDOTH and IDOT review and approval of Phase I deliverables.

The total for the amendment is \$201,542.00 which brings the contract total to \$3,084,269.00. Cost breakdown by firm is:

In accordance with revised IDOT BLRS guidelines, a \$78 max hourly rate is being used for this contract amendment along with the latest overhead rates approved by IDOT.

The contract goal for MBE/WBE participation is 35%. The original contract MBE/WBE participation was 40.89%. With this amendment, the updated participation will be 40.13%. Breakdown by firm is as follows:

Amendment #3
Scope of Work

This scope of work describes the modification of tasks required to complete the Pulaski Road Corridor Phase I study. These services are required to address elements that were not included in the original scope of work. The modifications result from changed conditions or new information that was identified during the course of the Phase I study, including additional drainage and utility investigations, modifications to the proposed Cal-Sag bridge improvement scope, and updating of environmental documentation to meet state requirements. An extension of the project schedule is required to address the design modifications and allow for CCDOTH and IDOT review and approval of Phase I deliverables. It is CCDOTH's expectation that this amendment includes sufficient supplemental scope and effort to gain design approval for this Phase I Study and additional amendments are not anticipated.

Task 1A - Data Collection (Benesch & Ardmore Roderick) – 200 hours

Initial Phase I tasks identified shallow rock and a large number of utilities in the Pulaski right-of-way. Detailed review and plotting of historic soil borings, as well as additional subsurface utility engineering (SUE), is required to confirm the depth of rock and associated impacts to the proposed drainage design.

Ardmore Roderick will perform subsurface utility engineering work including review of available utility information, field locating services, and potholing for select locations along the corridor. This information will be used to confirm soil boring locations are clear of utilities prior to field drilling. Field verified utility information will be displayed on preliminary design plan and profile sheets where available. This scope does not include SUE for the full project corridor. Spot locations and SUE level will be coordinated with CCDOTH and Rubino Engineering prior to performing the SUE services.

Task 2E - Environmental Surveys, Analysis and Coordination (Benesch & JLK) – 462 hour reduction

Benesch will prepare updated environmental documents which are required due to the extended project duration and finalized project limits. The following deliverables will be updated:

- Addendum ESR – 60 hrs
- PESA Update – 80 hrs + \$300 Direct Cost

This task will also be adjusted to remove historic preservation deliverables which have been determined to be unnecessary for the project. These include updates to the Bridge Condition Report, Area of Potential Effects report (APE), Historic Preservation Inventory (HPI), Effects Report, 106 Report, and Memorandum of Agreement (MOA).

Task 2F - Drainage Study (Benesch & 2iM) – 1050 hours

Supplemental drainage services are required to address added complexity and drainage areas that extended beyond the limits of the originally scoped contract. Additional optimization was required to address design alternatives and MWRD coordination.

Additional services to be performed by 2iM include:

1. More significant MWRD coordination and detailed alternatives analyses were required for this project, since the question of MWRD participation (whether they would participate, how much they'd participate, and how they'd participate) in the project was investigated. Three alternatives that divert the runoff away from the MWRD drop shaft include: (1) diverting Mosquito Creek outfall at the Cal-Sag Channel in separate pipes from the roadway (two systems); (2) diverting Mosquito Creek and roadway flows to the outfall at the Cal-Sag Channel in a single combined system; and (3) the selected alternative for maintenance of the existing Mosquito Creek discharge into the MWRD drop shaft while having a separate roadway-flow only system to the Cal-Sag Channel. Work also included meetings with the County and MWRD, a comparison of quantities and costs, and the associated exhibits. (80 hrs.)
2. While the original scope of work for the mainline Pulaski includes the ROW plus 50-100 ft beyond the ROW (about 100 acres), the actual evaluation included a mainline width of 1000 ft or more in some areas (430 acres). This is over 4 times the original scope area. Complete ROW adjacent tributary area drainage systems, analyses, exhibits, EDP, and PDP were needed for the additional areas that have gone well beyond customary 50-100 ft beyond the ROW. No changes to the number of plan sheets, but minor revisions on sheets only, particularly at 127th Street and 135th Street (EDP and PDP). (12 hrs.)

3. Evaluation of 75 existing MWRD permits along the Pulaski corridor and inclusion of associated pipe connections, revised drainage boundaries, model input, and EDP revisions. This number of permits exceeds a more usual expectation for about 20 permits for a County project of this length. The 75 permits could not have been estimated at the time of project scope development. (110 hrs.)
4. Major evaluation and re-evaluation of pipe size calculations due to the inclusion of the 430 acres of adjacent tributary drainage area (not the original 60 acres within 50-100 ft of the ROW) required supplemental work. Work progressed using latest default input into StormCAD. This initial effort was required to define the extent of large storm systems, possible insufficient cover, potential ponding, and the effect of Bulletin 75. Optimizing (reducing) the tributary areas followed. Drainage Structure losses were found to be significant when using the accepted default values from HEC-22, 3rd Edition, so a hybrid of 3rd Edition input was used for standard manholes and 2nd Edition input was used for Junction Chambers. This yielded more reasonable (lower) water surface elevations and HGLs. All work effort scaled up as a direct result of the much larger tributary area, and none of the optimizing work could have been done until the initial StormCAD effort was completed. (168 hrs.)
5. The Midlothian Creek hydraulic model used in the original analysis was HEC-RAS. It was developed based on the 2019 effective FEMA model. Since our original modelling effort, FEMA published a new FIS using a new model. This model will be requested from FEMA and used to perform the Phase I hydrologic and hydraulic analysis for Midlothian Creek. Work includes acquiring the model, importing Phase I survey cross sections into the model, and establishing boundary conditions and ineffective flow areas (32 hours); running and troubleshooting the model, creating a new WIT and hydraulic data sheets, and revising the hydraulic report text, figures, and exhibits (80 hours); two rounds of submittal comments, disposition of comments, and model/exhibit revisions (80 hours); and revising scour calculations (24 hours). (216 hrs.)
6. MWRD Tech Memo review is needed for combining the 96" MWRD pipe with the CCDOTH's Pulaski storm sewer system, extending 3,100 linear feet. Work includes review of the MWRD's model (no new modelling by 2im Group) (80 hours); and preparing review comments, coordination with CCDOTH and MWRD, three rounds of submittals, and associated meetings and disposition of comments (86 hours). Work assumes receipt of the model prepared by MWRD consultant. (166 hrs.)

Additional effort by Benesch is required for supplemental drainage services to meet Phase I requirements, including technical support, assistance in deliverable development and application of IDOT and CCDOTH requirements, coordination meetings with CCDOTH

regarding drainage deliverables, and integration of drainage design with roadway design and project report. These services will be provided for the Existing Drainage Plans (EDP, 32 hrs), Proposed Drainage Plans (PDP, 92 hours), Location Drainage Study (LDS, 74 hours), and Hydraulic Reports (20 hours). Benesch will also provide technical assistance in MWRD coordination and alternatives evaluation regarding coordination of the regional system with the proposed drainage system (80 hours).

Task 3G – Alternative Geometric Study (Benesch) – 448 hours

During the course of the Phase I, CCDOTH performed structural improvements to the Pulaski Road/Crawford Ave bridge over the Cal-Sag Channel. As a result of these improvements, replacement of the structure is no longer needed to meet the purpose and need of this study. Preliminary design plans and associated deliverables were prepared anticipating replacement, therefore will require updating to tie in with the existing structure to be maintained. Additionally, during the course of the Phase I study, new requirements for PROWAG and design exception forms were released and adopted by IDOT. Design deliverables will be updated for these new requirements to facilitate Phase I approval.

Specific tasks include:

- Review and update design to meet new PROWAG requirements (40 hrs)
- Redesign of geometrics from Lincoln Lane to 131st Street (156 hrs)
- Prepare design exceptions on newly released IDOT forms and associated attachments (252 hrs)

Task 4K – Agency Coordination & Meetings (Benesch) – 76 hours

Services include two additional IDOT coordination meetings anticipated to be required to finalize the geometric requirements at 127th Street and 147th Street, including preparation of meeting presentations and meeting minutes.

Bi-weekly coordination meetings for the extended project duration are also included.

Task 4L – Public Involvement Program (Benesch & RM Chin) – 36 hours

Additional services for maintaining and updating the project website and communications to stakeholders is included due to extended project duration. The services include one additional year of website hosting, project updates and administration. Benesch oversight of RM Chin outreach is included in this task.

Task 5N – Structural Studies (Benesch) – 400 hour reduction

Services include two additional IDOT coordination meetings anticipated to be required to finalize the geometric requirements at 127th Street and 147th Street, including preparation of meeting presentations and meeting minutes.

Bi-weekly coordination meetings for the extended project duration are also included.

Task 6O – Administration & Management (Benesch & 2iM) – 76 hours

Additional services for administration and management are required due to the extended project duration and additional tasks.

Task 6P – QA/QC (Benesch & 2iM) – 54 hours

Additional services for QA/QC are required due to the extended project duration and additional tasks.

JLK understands that Benesch is preparing a contract amendment for the Pulaski/Crawford Avenue Bridge Phase I Project (Project) to reflect direction from the Cook County Department of Transportation and Highways (CCDoTH).

In accordance with Amendment #2 for the Project, the project team investigated all feasible project alternatives to comply with Section 4(f) of the U.S. Department of Transportation Act. After CCDoTh performed structural improvements which improved the condition of the bridge in 2022, it was determined that replacement of the structure is no longer necessary to meet the purpose and need of the larger corridor improvements study along Crawford Avenue. As such, it is requested that the following JLK services associated with the replacement of the structure be removed from the contract, as the deliverables were determined to be no longer necessary by CCDoTH:

- Bridge Condition Report
- Area of Potential Effects (APE) Report
- Historic Properties Inventory (HPI)
- Assessment of Effects (AOE) Report
- Memorandum of Agreement (MOA)

The original JLK contract fee totaled **\$109,144**, of which **\$9,938.74** has been billed through June 17, 2024. 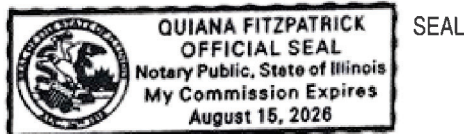

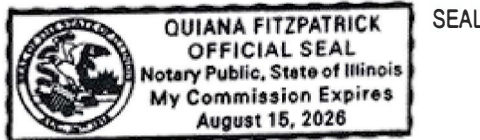

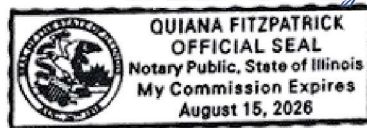

Any organization you newly acquire or form during the policy period over which you maintain 50% or more ownership interest and that is not separately insured for Business Auto Coverage. Coverage under this provision is afforded only until the 180th day after you acquire or form the organization or the end of the policy period, whichever is earlier.

B. BLANKET ADDITIONAL INSURED

The following is added to Paragraph **c.** in **A.1., Who Is An Insured**, of **SECTION II – COVERED AUTOS LIABILITY COVERAGE**:

Any person or organization who is required under a written contract or agreement between you and that person or organization, that is signed and executed by you before the "bodily injury" or "property damage" occurs and that is in effect during the policy period, to be named as an additional insured is an "insured" for Covered Autos Liability Coverage, but only for damages to which

this insurance applies and only to the extent that person or organization qualifies as an "insured" under the Who Is An Insured provision contained in Section II.

C. EMPLOYEE HIRED AUTO

- 1.** The following is added to Paragraph **A.1., Who Is An Insured**, of **SECTION II – COVERED AUTOS LIABILITY COVERAGE**:

An "employee" of yours is an "insured" while operating an "auto" hired or rented under a contract or agreement in an "employee's" name, with your permission, while performing duties related to the conduct of your business.

However, any "auto" that is leased, hired, rented or borrowed with a driver is not a covered "auto".

D. EMPLOYEES AS INSURED

The following is added to Paragraph **A.1., Who Is An Insured**, of **SECTION II – COVERED AUTOS LIABILITY COVERAGE**:

Any "employee" of yours is an "insured" while using a covered "auto" you don't own, hire or borrow in your business or your personal affairs.

E. SUPPLEMENTARY PAYMENTS – INCREASED LIMITS

1. The following replaces Paragraph **A.2.a.(2)**, of **SECTION II – COVERED AUTOS LIABILITY COVERAGE**:

(2) Up to \$3,000 for cost of bail bonds (including bonds for related traffic law violations) required because of an "accident" we cover. We do not have to furnish these bonds.

(5) Anywhere in the world, except any country or jurisdiction while any trade sanction, embargo, or similar regulation imposed by the United States of America applies to and prohibits the transaction of business with or within such country or jurisdiction, for Covered Autos Liability Coverage for any covered "auto" that you lease, hire, rent or borrow without a driver for a period of 30 days or less and that is not an "auto" you lease, hire, rent or borrow from any of your "employees", partners (if you are a partnership), members (if you are a limited liability company) or members of their households.

(a) With respect to any claim made or "suit" brought outside the United States of America, the territories and possessions of the United States of America, Puerto Rico and Canada:

(i) You must arrange to defend the "insured" against, and investigate or settle any such claim or "suit" and keep us advised of all proceedings and actions.

(ii) Neither you nor any other involved "insured" will make any settlement without our consent.

(iii) We may, at our discretion, participate in defending the "insured" against, or in the settlement of, any claim or "suit".

(iv) We will reimburse the "insured" for sums that the "insured" legally must pay as damages because of "bodily injury" or "property damage" to which this insurance applies, that the "insured" pays with our consent, but only up to the limit described in Paragraph **C., Limits Of Insurance**, of **SECTION II – COVERED AUTOS LIABILITY COVERAGE**.

(v) We will reimburse the "insured" for the reasonable expenses incurred with our consent for your investigation of such claims and your defense of the "insured" against any such "suit", but only up to and included within the limit described in Paragraph **C., Limits Of Insurance**, of **SECTION II – COVERED AUTOS LIABILITY COVERAGE**, and not in addition to such limit. Our duty to make such payments ends when we have used up the applicable limit of insurance in payments for damages, settlements or defense expenses.

(b) This insurance is excess over any valid and collectible other insurance available to the "insured" whether primary, excess, contingent or on any other basis.

(c) This insurance is not a substitute for required or compulsory insurance in any country outside the United States, its territories and possessions, Puerto Rico and Canada.

You agree to maintain all required or compulsory insurance in any such country up to the minimum limits required by local law. Your failure to comply with compulsory insurance requirements will not invalidate the coverage afforded by this policy, but we will only be liable to the same extent we would have been liable had you complied with the compulsory insurance requirements.

- (d) It is understood that we are not an admitted or authorized insurer outside the United States of America, its territories and possessions, Puerto Rico and Canada. We assume no responsibility for the furnishing of certificates of insurance, or for compliance in any way with the laws of other countries relating to insurance.

G. WAIVER OF DEDUCTIBLE – GLASS

The following is added to Paragraph D., **Deductible**, of **SECTION III – PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE**:

No deductible for a covered "auto" will apply to glass damage if the glass is repaired rather than replaced.

H. HIRED AUTO PHYSICAL DAMAGE – LOSS OF USE – INCREASED LIMIT

The following replaces the last sentence of Paragraph A.4.b., **Loss Of Use Expenses**, of **SECTION III – PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE**:

However, the most we will pay for any expenses for loss of use is \$65 per day, to a maximum of \$750 for any one "accident".

I. PHYSICAL DAMAGE – TRANSPORTATION EXPENSES – INCREASED LIMIT

We will pay up to \$50 per day to a maximum of \$1,500 for temporary transportation expense incurred by you because of the total theft of a covered "auto" of the private passenger type.

J. PERSONAL PROPERTY

The following is added to Paragraph A.4., **Coverage Extensions**, of **SECTION III – PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE**:

Personal Property

We will pay up to \$400 for "loss" to wearing apparel and other personal property which is:

- (1) Owned by an "insured"; and

- (2) In or on your covered "auto".

This coverage applies only in the event of a total theft of your covered "auto".

No deductibles apply to this Personal Property coverage.

K. AIRBAGS

The following is added to Paragraph B.3., **Exclusions**, of **SECTION III – PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE**:

Exclusion 3.a. does not apply to "loss" to one or more airbags in a covered "auto" you own that inflate due to a cause other than a cause of "loss" set forth in Paragraphs A.1.b. and A.1.c., but only:

- a. If that "auto" is a covered "auto" for Comprehensive Coverage under this policy;
- b. The airbags are not covered under any warranty; and
- c. The airbags were not intentionally inflated.

We will pay up to a maximum of \$1,000 for any one "loss".

L. NOTICE AND KNOWLEDGE OF ACCIDENT OR LOSS

The following is added to Paragraph A.2.a., of **SECTION IV – BUSINESS AUTO CONDITIONS**:

Your duty to give us or our authorized representative prompt notice of the "accident" or "loss" applies only when the "accident" or "loss" is known to:

- (a) You (if you are an individual);
- (b) A partner (if you are a partnership);
- (c) A member (if you are a limited liability company);
- (d) An executive officer, director or insurance manager (if you are a corporation or other organization); or
- (e) Any "employee" authorized by you to give notice of the "accident" or "loss".

M. BLANKET WAIVER OF SUBROGATION

The following replaces Paragraph A.5., **Transfer Of Rights Of Recovery Against Others To Us**, of **SECTION IV – BUSINESS AUTO CONDITIONS**:

5. Transfer Of Rights Of Recovery Against Others To Us

We waive any right of recovery we may have against any person or organization to the extent required of you by a written contract signed and executed prior to any "accident" or "loss", provided that the "accident" or "loss" arises out of operations contemplated by

COMMERCIAL AUTO

such contract. The waiver applies only to the person or organization designated in such contract.

N. UNINTENTIONAL ERRORS OR OMISSIONS

The following is added to Paragraph **B.2., Concealment, Misrepresentation, Or Fraud,** of **SECTION IV – BUSINESS AUTO CONDITIONS:**

The unintentional omission of, or unintentional error in, any information given by you shall not prejudice your rights under this insurance. However this provision does not affect our right to collect additional premium or exercise our right of cancellation or non-renewal.

EXCESS FOLLOW-FORM AND UMBRELLA LIABILITY INSURANCE

THIS POLICY, IN PART, PROVIDES FOLLOW-FORM LIABILITY COVERAGE. COVERAGE WILL APPLY ON A CLAIMS-MADE BASIS WHEN FOLLOWING CLAIMS-MADE UNDERLYING INSURANCE.

COVERAGE WILL APPLY ON A DEFENSE-WITHIN-LIMITS BASIS WHEN FOLLOWING UNDERLYING INSURANCE UNDER WHICH DEFENSE EXPENSES ARE PAYABLE WITHIN, AND NOT IN ADDITION TO, THE LIMITS OF INSURANCE. WHEN FOLLOWING SUCH UNDERLYING INSURANCE, PAYMENT OF DEFENSE EXPENSES UNDER THIS POLICY WILL REDUCE, AND MAY EXHAUST, THE LIMITS OF INSURANCE OF THIS POLICY.

PLEASE READ THE ENTIRE POLICY CAREFULLY.

Various provisions in this policy restrict coverage. Read the entire policy carefully to determine rights, duties and what is and is not covered.

Throughout this policy, the words "you" and "your" refer to the Named Insured shown in the Declarations and any other person or organization qualifying as a Named Insured under this policy. The words "we", "us" and "our" refer to the company providing this insurance.

The word "insured" means any person or organization qualifying as such under **SECTION II - WHO IS AN INSURED.**

Other words and phrases that appear in quotation marks have special meaning. Refer to **SECTION VI - DEFINITIONS.**

SECTION I - COVERAGES

A. COVERAGE A - EXCESS FOLLOW-FORM LIABILITY

1. We will pay on behalf of the insured those sums, in excess of the "applicable underlying limit", that the insured becomes legally obligated to pay as damages to which Coverage **A** of this insurance applies, provided that the "underlying insurance" would apply to such damages but for the exhaustion of its applicable limits of insurance. If a sublimit is specified in any "underlying insurance", Coverage **A** of this insurance applies to damages that are in excess of that sublimit only if such sublimit is shown for that "underlying insurance" in the Schedule Of Underlying Insurance.
2. Coverage **A** of this insurance is subject to the same terms, conditions, agreements, exclusions and definitions as the "underlying insurance", except with respect to any provisions to the contrary contained in this insurance.
3. The amount we will pay for damages is limited as described in **SECTION III - LIMITS OF INSURANCE.**
4. For the purposes of Paragraph 1. above:

- a. The applicable limit of insurance stated for the policies of "underlying insurance" in the Schedule Of Underlying Insurance will be considered to be reduced or exhausted only by the following payments:

- (1) Payments of judgments or settlements for damages that are covered by that "underlying insurance". However, if such "underlying insurance" has a policy period which differs from the policy period of this Excess Follow-Form And Umbrella Liability Insurance, any such payments for damages that would not be covered by this Excess Follow-Form And Umbrella Liability Insurance because of its different policy period will not reduce or exhaust the applicable limit of insurance stated for such "underlying insurance";
- (2) Payments of "medical expenses" that are covered by that "underlying insurance" and are incurred for "bodily injury" caused by an accident that takes place during the policy period of this Excess Follow-Form And Umbrella Liability Insurance; or

- b. To sue us on this insurance unless all of its terms have been fully complied with.
2. A person or organization may sue us to recover on an agreed settlement or on a final judgment against an insured. We will not be liable for damages that:
- a. Are not payable under the terms of this insurance; or
 - b. Are in excess of the applicable limit of insurance.

An agreed settlement means a settlement and release of liability signed by us, the insured and the claimant or the claimant's legal representative.

L. MAINTENANCE OF UNDERLYING INSURANCE

1. The insurance afforded by each policy of "underlying insurance" will be maintained for the full policy period of this Excess Follow-Form And Umbrella Liability Insurance. This provision does not apply to the reduction or exhaustion of the aggregate limit or limits of such "underlying insurance" solely by payments as permitted in Paragraphs 4.a.(1), (2) and (3) of **COVERAGE A – EXCESS FOLLOW-FORM LIABILITY OF SECTION I – COVERAGES**. As such policies expire, you will renew them at limits and with coverage at least equal to the expiring limits of insurance. If you fail to comply with the above requirements, Coverage A is not invalidated. However, in the event of a loss, we will pay only to the extent that we would have paid had you complied with the above requirements.
2. The first Named Insured shown in the Declarations must give us written notice of any change in the "underlying insurance" as respects:
- a. Coverage;
 - b. Limits of insurance;
 - c. Termination of any coverage; or
 - d. Exhaustion of aggregate limits.
3. If you are unable to recover from any "underlying insurer" because you fail to comply with any term or condition of the "underlying insurance", Coverage A is not invalidated. However, we will pay for any loss only to the extent that we would have paid had you complied with that term or condition in that "underlying insurance".

M. OTHER INSURANCE

This insurance is excess over any valid and collectible "other insurance" whether such "other insurance" is stated to be primary, contributing, excess, contingent or otherwise. This provision does not apply to a policy bought specifically to apply as excess of this insurance.

However, if you specifically agree in a written contract or agreement that the insurance provided to any person or organization that qualifies as an insured under this insurance must apply on a primary basis, or a primary and non-contributory basis, then insurance provided under Coverage A is subject to the following provisions:

- 1. This insurance will apply before any "other insurance" that is available to such additional insured which covers that person or organization as a named insured, and we will not share with that "other insurance", provided that the injury or damage for which coverage is sought is caused by an "event" that takes place or is committed subsequent to the signing of that contract or agreement by you.
- 2. This insurance is still excess over any valid and collectible "other insurance", whether primary, excess, contingent or otherwise, which covers that person or organization as an additional insured or as any other insured that does not qualify as a named insured.

N. PREMIUM

- 1. The first Named Insured shown in the Declarations is responsible for the payment of all premiums and will be the payee for any return premiums.
- 2. If the premium is a flat charge, it is not subject to adjustment except as provided in Paragraph 4. below.
- 3. If the premium is other than a flat charge, it is an advance premium only. The earned premium will be computed at the end of the policy period, or at the end of each year of the policy period if the policy period is two years or longer, at the rate shown in the Declarations, subject to the Minimum Premium.

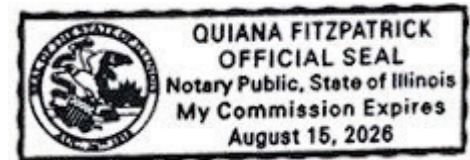

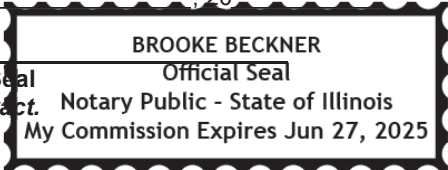

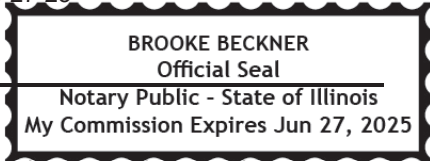
