Whereas, Amendment No. 5 was authorized by the Chief Procurement Officer on October 2, 2019 for a one-month renewal from November 1, 2019 through November 30, 2019; and

Whereas, Amendment No. 6 was authorized by the County Board on November 21, 2019 for an eleven (11) month renewal from December 1, 2019 through October 31, 2020 and to increase the contract in the amount of \$4,305,866.00 and the Total Contract Amount was revised to \$14,423,803.50; and

Whereas, Amendment No. 7 was authorized by the Chief Procurement Officer on November 16, 2020 for a three month renewal from November 1, 2020 through January 31, 2021; and

Whereas, Amendment No. 8 was authorized by the Chief Procurement Officer on February 19, 2021 for a three month renewal from February 1, 2021 through April 30, 2021 and to increase the contract in the amount of \$145,000 and the Total Contract Amount was revised to \$14,568,803.50; and

- 4. All other terms and conditions remain as stated in the Contract.
