AMENDMENT NO. 1

This Amendment modifies Contract No. 1614-15614, for Accounting and Cashiering System Professional Services: Support/Maintenance/Software by and between the County of Cook, Illinois, herein referred to as "County" and Business Microvar, Inc. (dba) InterDyn BMII authorized to do business in the State of Illinois hereinafter referred to as "Contractor":

RECITALS

Whereas, the County and Contractor have entered into a Contract approved by the County Board on December 14, 2016, (hereinafter referred to as the "Contract"), wherein the Contractor is to provide Accounting and Cashiering System Professional Services: Support/Maintenance/Software (hereinafter referred to as the "Services") from December 14, 2016 through December 13, 2018, with one (1) one-year renewal option, in an amount not to exceed \$264,095.20; and

Whereas, the Contract will expire December 13, 2018, and the agreed upon Services are still required; and

Whereas, an increase in the amount of \$77,960.92 is required for the continuation of Services; and

Whereas, the County and Contractor desire to renew the Contract for twelve (12) months beginning on December 14, 2018 through December 13, 2019; and

Whereas, Business Microvar, Inc. (dba) InterDyn BMI underwent a corporate reorganization and requests the Contract be assigned to Columbus US, Inc.

Now therefore, in consideration of mutual covenants contained herein, it is agreed by and between the parties to amend the Contract as follows:

- 1. The Contract is renewed through December 13, 2019.
- 2. As per Article 3. k., Subcontracting or Assignment of Contract or Contract Funds, the Contract is hereby assigned from Business Microvar, Inc. (dba) InterDyn BMI to Columbus US, Inc. Any reference to Business Microvar, Inc. (dba) InterDyn BMI in the Contract shall be changed to Columbus US, Inc., who shall be the "Contractor".
- 3. Article 5, Compensation, Section b), Method of Payment, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

All invoices submitted by the Contractor shall be in accordance with the cost provisions contained in the Contract Documents and shall contain a detailed description of the Deliverables (i.e., the goods, equipment, supplies, or services) including the quantity of the Deliverables, for which payment is requested. All invoices for services shall include itemized entries indicating the date or time period in which the services were provided, the amount of time spent performing the services, and a detailed description of the services provided during the period of the invoice. All Contracts for services that are procured as Sole Source must also contain a provision requiring the Contractor to submit itemized records indicating the dates that services were provided, a detailed description of the work performed on each such date, and the amount of time spent performing work on each such date. All invoices shall reflect the amounts invoiced by and the amounts paid to the Contractor as of the date of the invoice. Invoices for new charges shall not include "past due" amounts, if any, which amounts must be set forth on a separate invoice. Contractor shall not be entitled to invoice the County for any late fees or other penalties.

In accordance with Section 34-177 of the Cook County Procurement Code, the County shall have a right to set off and subtract from any invoice(s) or Contract price, a sum equal to any fines and penalties, including interest, for any tax or fee delinquency and any debt or obligation owed by the Contractor to the County.

The Contractor acknowledges its duty to ensure the accuracy of all invoices submitted to the County for payment. By submitting the invoices, the Contractor certifies that all itemized entries set forth in the invoices are true and correct. The Contractor acknowledges that by submitting the invoices, it certifies that it has delivered the Deliverables, i.e., the goods, supplies or equipment set forth in the Contract to the Using Agency, or that it has properly performed the services set forth

in the Contract. The invoice must also reflect the dates and amount of time expended in the provision of services under the Contract.

The Contractor acknowledges that any inaccurate statements or negligent or intentional misrepresentations in the invoices shall result in the County exercising all remedies available to it in law and equity including, but not limited to, a delay in payment or non-payment to the Contractor, and reporting the matter to the Cook County Office of the Independent Inspector General.

- 4. The Contract is increased by \$77,960.92 and the Total Contract Amount is revised to \$342,056.12.
- 5. The Contract is hereby amended to incorporate Attachment A and made part of the Contract.
- 6. The attached Identification of Sub-Contractors/Suppliers/Sub-Consultants Form, MBE/WBE Utilization Plan forms, and Economic Disclosures Statement under Attachment B are incorporated and made a part of this Contract.
- 7. All other terms and conditions remain as stated in the Contract.

- 3) Has been convicted of bid-rigging or attempting to rig bids under the laws of federal, state or local government;
- 4) Has been convicted of an act committed, within the State, of price-fixing or attempting to fix prices as defined by the Sherman Anti-Trust Act and the Clayton Act. 15 U.S.C. Section 1, et seq.;
- Has been convicted of price-fixing or attempting to fix prices under the laws the State;
- 6) Has been convicted of defrauding or attempting to defraud any unit of state or local government or school district within the State of Illinois;
- 7) Has made an admission of guilt of such conduct as set forth in subsections (1) through (6) above which admission is a matter of record, whether or not such person or business entity was subject to prosecution for the offense or offenses admitted to; or
- 8) Has entered a plea of *nolo contendere* to charge of bribery, price-fixing, bid-rigging, or fraud, as set forth in sub-paragraphs (1) through (6) above.

FAMILIAL RELATIONSHIP DISCLOSURE PROVISION

Nepotism Disclosure Requirement:

Doing a significant amount of business with the County requires that you disclose to the Board of Ethics the existence of any familial relationships with any County employee or any person holding elective office in the State of Illinois, the County, or in any municipality within the County. The Ethics Ordinance defines a significant amount of business for the purpose of this disclosure requirement as more than \$25,000 in aggregate County leases, contracts, purchases or sales in any calendar year.
