

AMENDMENT NO. 1

This Amendment modifies Contract No. 2115-11193, for Pavement Markings Countywide by and between the County of Cook, Illinois, herein referred to as "County" and Preform Traffic Control Systems, Ltd., authorized to do business in the State of Illinois hereinafter referred to as "Contractor":

RECITALS

Whereas, the County and Contractor have entered into a Contract approved by the County Board on April 7, 2022, (hereinafter referred to as the "Contract"), wherein the Contractor is to provide Pavement Markings Countywide, (hereinafter referred to as the "Services") from April 7, 2022 through April 6, 2025, in an amount not to exceed \$7,745,100.00, with no renewal options; and

Whereas, the Contract will expire April 6, 2025, and the agreed upon Services are still required; and

Whereas, pursuant to GC-10 of the Contract, the County and Contractor desire to extend the Contract for a period of six (6) months, from April 7, 2025, through October 6, 2025.

Whereas a decrease of the Contract amount is required for the continuation of Services; and pursuant to GC-07 of the Contract, the County and Contractor desire to decrease the Contract in the amount of \$322,472.44; and

Now therefore, in consideration of mutual covenants contained herein, it is agreed by and between the parties to amend the Contract as follows:

1. The Contract is extended through October 6, 2025.
2. The Contract is decreased by \$322,472.44 and the Total Contract Amount is revised to \$7,422,627.56.
3. The Contract is hereby amended to incorporate Attachment A and made part of the Contract.
4. The attached updated Identification of Sub-Contractors/Suppliers/Sub-Consultants Form, MBE/WBE Utilization Plan Forms, Certificate of Insurance (if updated), and Economic Disclosures Statement under Attachment B are incorporated and made part of this Contract.
5. All other terms and conditions remain as stated in the Contract.

The Contract is decreased by \$322,472.44 and the Total Contract Amount is revised to \$7,422,627.56.


The Contract is hereby amended to and is replace it with the attached Attachment A.

Additional quantities of PAINT PAVEMENT MARKING LINE 12 INCH and 24 INCH, and RECESSED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MAKER (HMA) were required due to field conditions to properly maintain Roadways within the County.

Item #2, #3, #4, #8, #9, and #10
